This Docking Agreement is for a period from _____ to _____ inclusive.

Please be advised this is a trial program for dinghy vessels at the East Creek Docking Facility. The program can be terminated at any time during the season by the Recreation Department. No refunds will be provided.

Special Terms and Conditions

- Permit is required for Dinghy Space at East Creek Docking Facility. No Dinghy shall be placed until a permit is issued. Permits will be issued on a first come, first serve basis.
- One dinghy vessel per active East Creek Marina member
- Dinghy can be no more than 12 feet, Total Vessel Length.
- All Dinghy's must be secured with chain or cable and locks
- If vessel has an engine, engine cannot be more than 10HP
- Dinghy must be registered with registration numbers visible
- Owner must remove dinghy if there is an impending storm, if owner fails to remove vessel it will be towed at owners expense and will incur impound fees
- Max of 6 dinghies per dock 1-5, location TBD by Recreation Department.
- Dinghy's not properly secured will be removed at the owners expense.
- It shall be the responsibility of the permit holder to notify the Recreation Department of any change in address or dinghy size related to any dinghy space permit.
- **Transfer of Dinghy space permits is prohibited.** No Dinghy space permit shall be sold, assigned or otherwise transferred by a permit holder.
- The Town of Riverhead is not liable for any loss, or damage to, any dinghy
- All contact information for dinghy owner must be up to date and a cellular phone number must be provided

- Lease period will be from June 4th through November 15th
- Tenant agrees that a penalty for failure to remove a vessel at the end of the season in the amount of \$250.00 per day shall be imposed. In addition, Tenant agrees that the Town may remove any abandoned vessel at the owner's expense.
- All vessels will be subject to periodic inspections by the Town of Riverhead Bay Constable
- One permit shall be allowed per resident
- No permit may be used for commercial purposes
- The Town or the Town Board shall not be responsible for any personal injury, loss of life or damage to property of the applicant or passengers, guests, spectators or employees of the applicant in connection with the use of the docking facility.
- Acceptance of a permit to utilize a slip shall constitute an agreement that the applicant will hold the Town of Riverhead and its authorized representatives completely harmless of any liability in connection with the operation of the vessel.
- Applications received without payment will be returned
- Vessel assignments will be made at the discretion of the Recreation Department.
- No refunds at any time unless the Recreation Department deemed it necessary based on circumstances
- All tenants must be in compliance with Chapter A113 of the Riverhead Town Code which is available on the Town website @ www.townofriverheadny.gov

Any violation to the above terms and conditions can be subject to loss of boat slip
