

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to The Town of Riverhead summer camp at the George Young Community Center (GYCC)! I am so excited for an amazing summer together. This year at the George Young Community Center location in Jamesport, Miss Kelly will be the Site Coordinator, Miss Hannah will be the Trip Leader for the “Littles” (1st-3rd Grade) group and Miss Logann will be the Trip Leader for the “Bigs” (4th-6th Grade) group. Before coming to camp, there are a few things I would like to share and request.

- Remember, our camp is **NUT FREE!** Please look at the labels of your child’s snacks and lunches and ensure they DO NOT contain any kinds of nuts. This includes anything that contains, may contain, or has traces of peanuts, tree nuts, hazelnuts, etc.
- Please pack your child with a lunch and 2 snacks every day, as well as plenty of water unless otherwise noted. We will have a morning snack and an afternoon snack, so please pack accordingly.
- We are an extremely active camp therefore it is important to make sure your child wears comfortable clothes and sneakers daily. On beach days, we ask that if your child wears sandals/flip flops, you also send them with sneakers to change into.
- On trip days and beach days, campers **MUST** wear their camp shirts, which will be given to your camper in advance.
- This year I request all children bring in a change of clothing in a gallon zip lock bag with their name on it, in case of an emergency. These should stay in their backpacks at all times.

I am very excited for summer to begin! All information and calendars can be found by going to the Riverhead Recreation website listed below. Please note which days are beach days, trip days, and theme days. They may change week to week. Normal camp hours are 8:45-4:45. I look forward to seeing and meeting all of you and the campers on Monday, July 3rd.

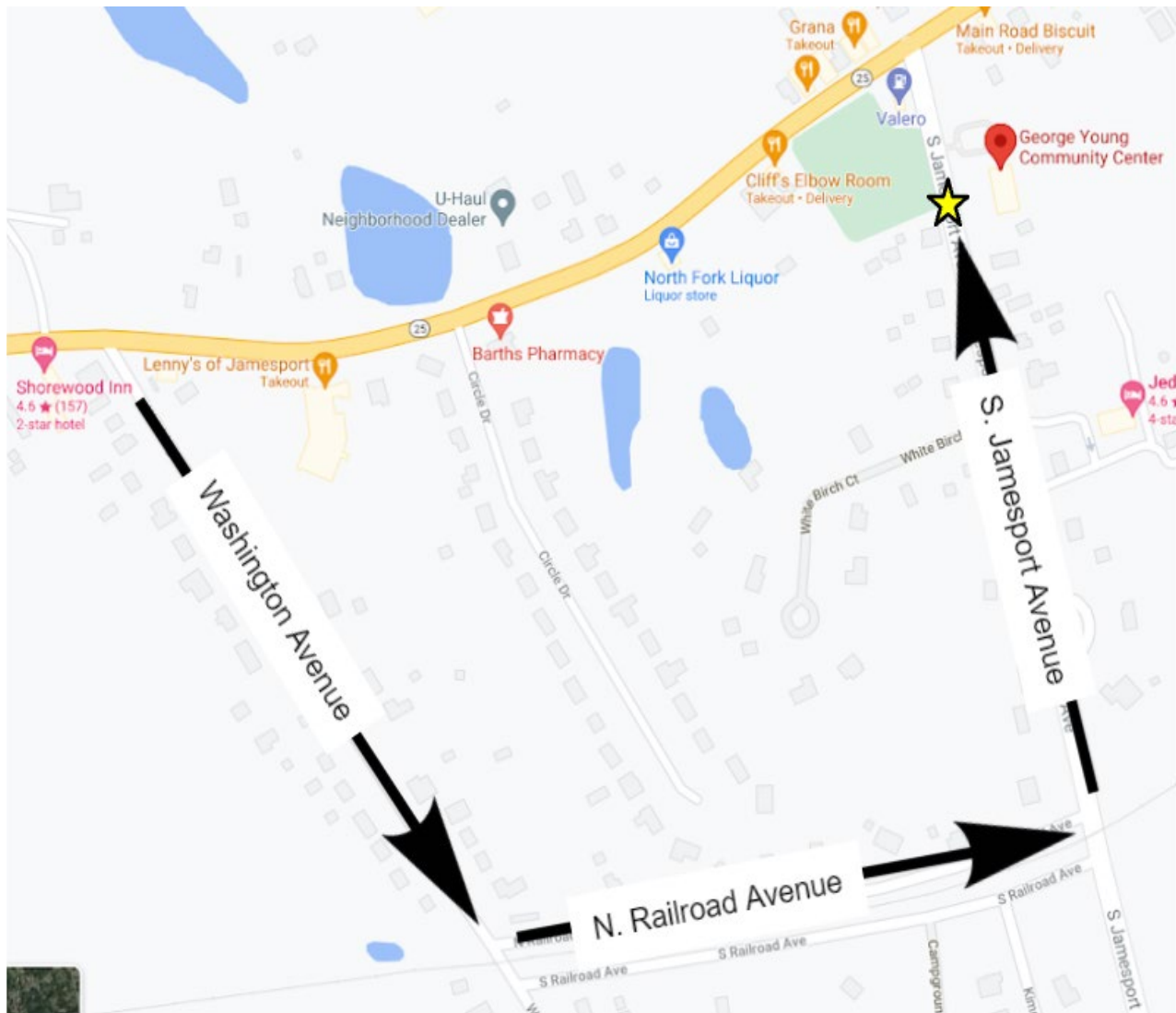

GYCC Drop Off/Pick Up

To ensure a safe and smooth drop off and pick up, we will be continuing with the car loop that we had last year. This year, cars must line up on the east side of South Jamesport Avenue (the side of the road that the building is on). During drop off, when it is your turn to pull up to one of our staff, please roll down your window to let us know who you're dropping off. Please make sure your child is ready to get out of the car to help us keep the line moving smoothly. Parents/guardians may not leave until they're given a thumbs up by the site coordinator confirming that their camper is signed in.

Below is a map showing an alternative route that you can travel to be on the correct side of the street. If you choose to turn onto South Jamesport Ave. from the Main Rd., you will have to join the line by making a three point turn at the end of the line.
