



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

HOW DO I REGISTER?

You can register in person at our office locations, over the phone, or by visiting our registration website www.riverheadrecreation. com.When registering online for the first time new registrants will be asked to create an online account before registering for programs. Proof of residency is required when registering for classes annually. Acceptable proofs of residency include a current tax bill, utility bill, a rental or lease agreement, or driver's license.

WHAT ARE MY PAYMENT OPTIONS?

Registration and payment is required for all programs, unless otherwise noted. Acceptable forms of payment include cash, check, or credit/debit cards. Credit requests must be submitted at least five days prior to the start of the program and are subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. In the event that the Recreation Department cancels a program or event, registrants may be eligible for a full refund or a department credit.
