

# Town of Riverhead Pickleball Ladder League

## Rules & Regulations

### What is the Ladder League?

This format allows for players to play among people of similar skill levels. The ladder is a fun way to play with new people in an organized, social yet competitive way. **Your ranking** on the ladder depends on your winning percentage from previous weeks of play.

### SCORING/LADDER MOVEMENT

- Courts will have between 4 and 7 players and will rotate to play with each person as their partner, depending on the number of players there. Courts with 4 players will play their games to 15 points, Courts with 5+ will play games to 11. **(WIN BY 2 DOES NOT APPLY)**
  - It is required that the players change ends of the court when one side has 8 points or 6 points depending on the number of players on the court to minimize the effects of the sun/wind.
- After your games have been played, players record their scores on the score sheet available with the staff on site.
- Winning percentage will determine your rank on the ladder. (the ratio of points won / points available) The number of points available will depend on how many players are on your court and how many points each game is being played to.
  - There is a TIER system in place. Tier 1 begins at skill level 3.5+ and Tier 2 is 2.0-3.0. However, after the first round of play and subsequent rounds of play, players will move up and down each tier OR up to the next tier or down to the lower tier.
  - Players will move up a tier if they have a scoring percentage of 84% or more
  - Players will move down a tier if they have a scoring percentage of 65% or less.

### ATTENDANCE

- Each week you are expected to play in your ladder match unless you have notified Ashley that you will be absent. **Only notify if you WILL NOT attend.** This can be done via email [schandel@townofriverheadny.gov](mailto:schandel@townofriverheadny.gov) or call 631-727-3200 x733.
  - 6pm Night leagues: **Please notify by 12pm that day or earlier. Schedule posted 12pm.**
  - 10am Morning leagues: **Please notify by the night before. Schedule posted 8am.**
